We are excited to share that our first surveys are now well underway. These surveys will help inform the Ambrosia Wind Farm design, and future approvals documentation.

The wet weather did not stop our consultants from visiting the Moodiarrup region the week starting Monday 27th May 2024. The ecological survey of the area helps to determine the condition and potential significance of flora and fauna, and areas for avoidance. This information will help also inform the areas for targeted spring surveys later in the year.

Further surveys and field assessments will be commencing in the coming weeks.
