Over the last few weeks, the team at Green Wind Renewables have been busy continuing to meet with landowners. We've also undertaken a number of surveys in the area that will help inform the Ambrosia Wind Farm design, and future approvals documentation.

We have a strong commitment to renewable energy projects in Western Australia. The Ambrosia Wind Farm is one project we are currently working on, and since our founding in 2019 we have grown rapidly, now employing 19 staff. We are actively engaging with local and state government departments around the creation of wind farms in Western Australia.

Consultation for our Ambrosia Wind Farm is an ongoing process, which at the local level starts with the project hosts and grows over time to include neighbours, local government, community members, community groups and businesses. Spring has sprung, it's time to survey!

Green Wind Renewables is about to start our spring surveys. This survey aims to identify and evaluate the biodiversity of the Ambrosia Wind Farm site, focusing on the presence and condition of various plants. Spring surveys are aptly named as they are conducted in spring, when many flora species are identifiable due to the presence of flowers, providing a more accurate assessment of the site's biodiversity.

The spring survey for Ambrosia Wind Farm will take approximately one week, conducted on foot by our botanist consultants. Some plant samples may be taken to assist with identification at the State's herbarium.

Findings from the survey will help develop the design of the Ambrosia Wind Farm, future approvals documentation, and creating mitigation strategies to minimise negative impacts on the environment in the area.
