



## Meteorological Mast going up!

We are proud to share that following the recent Development Application approved by the Shire of West Arthur, construction on the meteorological mast for the Ambrosia Wind Farm will begin shortly with the aim to be fully constructed and operational by Christmas.

The metrological mast will be approximately 150 metres tall with wind monitoring devices installed at varying heights on the mast to measure wind speeds. This data will provide valuable input into the selection of the optimal wind turbine for the Ambrosia Wind Farm, as well as contribute to the final layout of the wind farm.
