



Bird Surveying

In the coming weeks, Green Wind Renewables will be conducting our third bird survey for the Ambrosia Wind Farm. During these surveys a group of environmental scientists walk the area of the proposed wind farm documenting bird species, habitats, population numbers, roosting areas, and food sources. Photos are also taken of different bird species and bushland.

It is important to conduct these surveys numerous times to understand seasonal presence and movements as well as meet regulatory standards.

With this data, the design of the wind farm can be refined to ensure important bird habitats are avoided, and mitigation strategies can be developed to ensure any impacts on local bird species, particularly of listed threatened species or listed migratory species, are minimised where possible.
